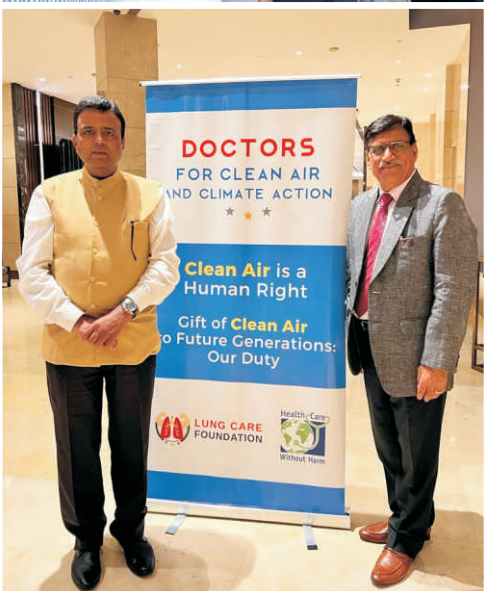

Keeping all this in mind, IMA Headquarters, has Declared Blood Donation Week from, 1st July 2023(Doctors Day) to 7th July 2023. During this period, all IMA State and Territorial Branches are advised to organize Blood Donation camps on dates of their convenience and motivate more and more Blood donors to come forward, thereby sending a message to public. SURPLUS NATION". In this connection, we have written to Dr. Vanshree Singh, Director, Indian Red Cross, Delhi regarding Collaboration of Indian Red Cross in IMA Blood Donation Week, starting from Doctors Day, 1st July 2023 to 7th July 2023, all across India to further this cause.

IMA (Hqs.) has organised a Walkathon from India Gate to IMA HQs. (about 3 kms.) on 10th June, 2023 (Saturday) to educate the public about the ill-effects of noise pollution and the precautions we should take to prevent the effects. IMA requested all its States and Local Branches to organise Walkathon/Conferences/ Rallies etc. on this day on the issues related to Safe Sound and apprise the public about the impact of noise pollution and also requested to percolate this information down to all members.

I am also pleased to inform you that Dr. R. V. Asokan, National President (Elect), IMA has been the IMA National Coordinator for Tuberculosis for 6 years and the Chairman of IMA End TB Initiative for further 6 years. He has been a member of WHO STAG TB and also the current alternative member of STOP TB Board. He represents IMA the largest professional organisation of modern medicine doctors in India and its interest in bringing TB epidemic to an end. He will represent IMA in the United Nations High-Level Meeting (HLM) on Tuberculosis on 22nd September, 2023 in New York. The IMA has been at the forefront of the fight against Tuberculosis, working in collaboration with the Government of India.

A mega Re-launch of IMA Aao Gaon Chalen Project has been organised by IMA (Hqs.). This is a dream project of our Chief Patron, Dr. Ketan Desai. This project has been celebrated all over the country on 25th June, 2023. The Goal of the project is to bring about holistic improvement in the village health scenario using existing infrastructure and promoting inter-sectoral coordination & networking through active involvement of IMA, Public Sector health delivery system and the community. To encourage this project the following Awards were announced by IMA (Hqs.):

First Cash Prize : Rs.3,00,000/- to the Local Branch

Second Cash Prize : Rs.2,00,000/- to the Local Branch

Third Cash Prize : Rs.1,00,000/- to the Local Branch

Certificate and Dr. Ketan Desai – Aao Gaon Chalen Award to the President and Secretary of the Local Branch.

The above Awards will be given either after the completion of one year on 24th June, 2024 or on Doctors Day next year.

The teams of Doctors in different parts of the country organized visit to the villages adopted by the respective branch and Health check-up camps for different diseases were organized in many villages in different parts were conducted and rural population was made aware of the medical treatment and many kinds of diseases generating due to the bad atmosphere and pollution in their areas. This project included many high-profile dignitaries and eminent personalities of different fields and made the mega Re-launch project successful throughout the nation.

In a recent past, some medical students of Gautam Budh University were profusely beaten by a group of Security Guards armed with rods, guns and sticks. In this regard, a letter was written to Shri Yogi Adityanath Ji, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Uttar Pradesh to intervene in the incident. Concept Note on Aao Gaon Chalen

Aao Gaon Chalen has been an important initiative of IMA to reach the community with multiple healthcare and allied services, and launched by our leader Dr. Ketan Desai in 2004. Its purpose has been to increase our reach to the community, proper documentation of services that are being provided by us and their projection to the Govt. by quantifying the net total of our services for the last 19 years. Some States have performed very well over the years but other states did not do much activity in a proper way. IMA (Hqs.) has taken up this project again in a big way and we are trying to reach at least 1700 villages of the country through the State leadership so that each one of them can adopt one village and provide multiple healthcare activities on a regular basis.

How to adopt a village :

- Select a village or cluster or urban slum near to the branch jurisdiction.
- Select an area where deficiency in the form of health services, water and sanitation services, family welfare, immunization are inadequate.
- Discuss with Local Administration, Municipal Health department about existing gaps in the area where IMA can pitch in.
- You will realize many villages have been adopted by various Members of Parliament under the Prime Minister monitored schemes which can be adopted by us.

Purpose :

- IMA would be providing only complimentary support to help the local authorities to achieve health and other health Related Indicators.
- A brief health survey of the area should be taken up to understand their requirements.
- Organize a meeting with community levels stakeholders to understand their needs.
- Meet local Govt. officials and health authorities and coordinate with them.
- Work out an execution plan whereby we are providing a sustainable activity and not just a one time or one month Activity.
- Identify team of dedicated, willing IMA workers who would be ready to work on a continuous basis.
- Regular review meetings should be held to fill the gap wherever there are.
- Monthly activity report should be sent to IMA (Hqs.).

Suggested Activities :

- Anemia control
 - Immunization
 - Pre Natal and Post Natal care
 - Cancer awareness and screening
 - Awareness about Hygiene, education and social welfare
 - Capacity building of existing healthcare providers
 - Health education
 - Need of safe water Supply
 - Develop a robust system for referral in all types of emergencies with the local health care institutions in and around the village
- Depending upon the area and its requirements the above activities can be enlarged and many more initiatives can be taken.

Aao Gaon Chalen can be a game changer activity to change the perception of public, media and administration about Indian Medical Association and its members. It is our continued commitments that can bring change in the health care scenario of the country especially in rural area.

Reporting :

While sending a monthly report the branch should identify the few indicators of services in the area provided by IMA and report before 7th of next month. Few illustrations can be :-

- Number of children receiving Polio Vaccination, DPT Vaccination, Measles Vaccination or Penta valent Vaccination
- The number of pregnant women registered, counselling done. TT Doses given, regular ante natal visits, iron folic tablets distribution, motivation for institutional deliveries
- Number of awareness classes on Hygiene and sanitation held.
- Number of persons attending the programs
- Number of people attending the OPD services.
- Number of patients referred to other Govt. institutions. Number of IMA doctors/health care workers providing their services, their name and contact details
- We will share with you the link for reporting your activities on a monthly basis very soon.

Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission



First thing first-Its completely different from Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojna (AB-PMJAY) Health Scheme.

Vision-

To create a national digital health ecosystem that supports universal health coverage in an efficient, accessible, inclusive, affordable, timely and safe manner, that provides a wide-range of data, information and infrastructure services, duly leveraging open, interoperable, standards-based digital systems, and ensures the security, confidentiality and privacy of health-related personal information.

Objectives-

To strengthen the accessibility and equity of health services, including continuum of care with citizen as the owner of data, in a holistic healthcare programme approach leveraging IT & associated technologies and support the existing health systems in a 'citizen-centric' approach, the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) envisages the following specific objectives:

- 1- To establish state-of-the-art digital health systems, to manage the core digital health data, and the infrastructure required for its seamless exchange;
- 2- To establish registries at appropriate level to create single source of truth in respect of clinical establishments, healthcare professionals, health workers, drugs and pharmacies;
- 3- To enforce adoption of open standards by all national digital health stakeholders;
- 4- To create a system of personal health records, based on international standards, easily accessible to individuals and healthcare professionals and services providers, based on individual's informed consent;
- 5- To promote development of enterprise-class health application systems with a special focus on achieving the Sustainable Development Goals for health;
- 6- To adopt the best principles of cooperative federalism while working with the States and Union Territories for the realisation of the vision;
- 7- To ensure that the healthcare institutions and professionals in the private sector participate actively with public health authorities in the building of the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), through a combination of prescription and promotion;
- 8- To ensure national portability in the provision of health services;
- 9- To promote the use of clinical decision support (CDS) systems by health professionals and practitioners;
- 10- To promote a better management of the health sector leveraging health data analytics and medical research;
- 11- To provide for enhancing the efficiency and effectiveness of governance at all levels;
- 12- To support effective steps being taken for ensuring quality of healthcare; and
- 13- To strengthen existing health information systems, by ensuring their conformity with the defined standards and integration with the proposed Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM).

The current strong public digital infrastructure—including that related to Aadhaar, Unified Payments Interface and wide reach of the Internet and mobile phones (JAM trinity) —provides a strong platform for establishing the building blocks of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM). The existing ability to digitally identify people, doctors, and health facilities, facilitate electronic signatures, ensure non- repudiable contracts, make paperless payments, securely store digital records, and contact people provide opportunities to streamline healthcare information through digital management.

Benefits-

1- The implementation of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) is expected to significantly improve the efficiency, effectiveness, and transparency of health service delivery overall. Patients will be able to securely store and access their medical records (such as prescriptions, diagnostic reports and discharge summaries), and share them with health care providers to ensure appropriate treatment and follow-up. They will also have access to more accurate information on health facilities and service providers. Further, they will have the option to access health services remotely through tele-consultation and e-pharmacy.

Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) will empower individuals with accurate information to enable informed decision making and increase accountability of healthcare providers.

2- Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) will provide choice to individuals to access both public and private health services, facilitate compliance with laid down guidelines and protocols, and ensure transparency in pricing of services and accountability for the health services being rendered.

3- Similarly, health care professionals across disciplines will have better access to patient's medical history (with the necessary informed consent) for prescribing more appropriate and effective health interventions. The integrated ecosystem will also enable better continuum of care. Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) will help digitize the claims process and enable faster reimbursement. This will enhance the overall ease of providing services amongst the health care providers.

4- At the same time, policy makers and programme managers will have better access to data, enabling more informed decision making by the Government. Better quality of macro and micro-level data will enable advanced analytics, usage of health-biomarkers and better preventive healthcare. It will also enable geography and demography-based monitoring and appropriate decision making to inform design and strengthen implementation of health programmes and policies.

5- Finally, researchers will greatly benefit from the availability of such aggregated information as they will be able to study and evaluate the effectiveness of various programmes and interventions. Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) would facilitate a comprehensive feedback loop between researchers, policymakers, and providers.

Building Blocks-

1- Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) Number-

It is important to standardize the process of identification of an individual across healthcare providers. This is the only way to ensure that the created medical records are issued to the correct individual or accessed by Health Information User through appropriate consent. In order to issue the UHID, the system must collect certain basic details including demographic and location, family/relationship, and contact details. Ability to update contact information easily is the key. The ABHA number will be used for the purposes of uniquely identifying persons, authenticating them, and threading their health records (only with the informed consent of the patient) across multiple systems and stakeholders.

2- Healthcare Professionals Registry (HPR)

It is a comprehensive repository of all healthcare professionals involved in delivery of healthcare services across both modern and traditional systems of medicine. Enrolling in the Healthcare Professionals Registry will enable them to get connected to India's digital health ecosystem.

3- Health Facility Registry (HFR)

It is a comprehensive repository of health facilities of the nation across different systems of medicine. It includes both public and private health facilities including hospitals, clinics, diagnostic laboratories and imaging centers, pharmacies, etc. Enrolling in the Health Facility Registry will enable them to get connected to India's digital health ecosystem.

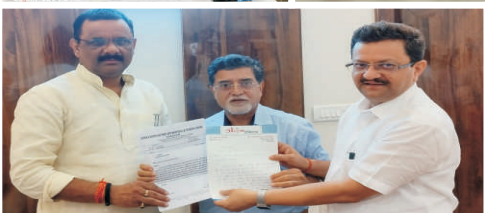

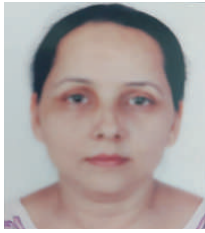

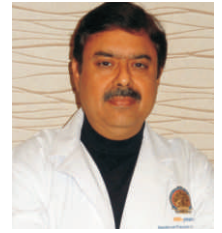
