Respected Sir.

Greetings from Indian Medical Association UP State!

With due respect, I would like to inform to your good honour that on 4th June, 2023, a group of security guards armed with rods, guns and sticks forcefully entered into the hostel premises of MBBS students at GIMS, Greater Noida, (UP) and broke the gates of the rooms in which MBBS students were residing. The medical students of GIMS are residing in the same hostel allotted to the students of Gautam Budh University. The innocent students were dragged out of their rooms and brutally beaten-up with rods and sticks. More than 20+ students sustained serious injuries and many more minor injuries. Four students met with severe fractures. All the vehicles of the students including car of the hostel warden was vandalized / damaged very badly.

Sir, this incident is a sad and dark day for the medical fraternity when the MBBS students in the college hostel face this merciless act by the security guards acting under the direct orders of the GBU security officer (SO).

We 22000 members at IMA UP State are extremely worried and concerned about the safety of medical students of aforementioned medical college. The IMA condemns the incident. The students are under pressure of undue fear and not feeling safe in the hostel premises and are afraid of re-occurrence of incident. It is therefore requested for your immediate intervention in the matter to take a stringent action against the culprits. It is also requested that a safe atmosphere for the medical students may be created in the college and hostel premises and build a separate hostel for medical students so that they feel safe and there were no such incidents taking place in future.
